

We also give services for


children with disability who get NDIS funding

Your rights when we help you

Rights are things that every person should have.



1 You have the right to choose



You can tell us what you think will help you and your family.



We will talk to you about what you want to do.



2 You have the right to feel safe

Our services should

• be safe



• not harm you.

3 We will respect you



Respect means we understand that

everyone is important



• we should be kind to everyone.

4 We will keep your information safe



To help you we need to know some information about you, like

• your name and phone number



why you need help.



The law says we **must** keep your information safe.



If we need to get information about you from someone else we will ask you first.



Only our staff who have permission can see or copy your information.



We will only share your information

• to keep you or others safe




• if the law says we must.



For example, we can share your information with the police if we think you are in danger.



The law says you can ask to see the information we have about you.

you are **not** happy




and



You should tell us information that can help us to support you.




We might find it hard to help you if you do **not** tell us some information.

• ask for the **police**.


